STIRRING SPEECH BY LIBERAL LEADER

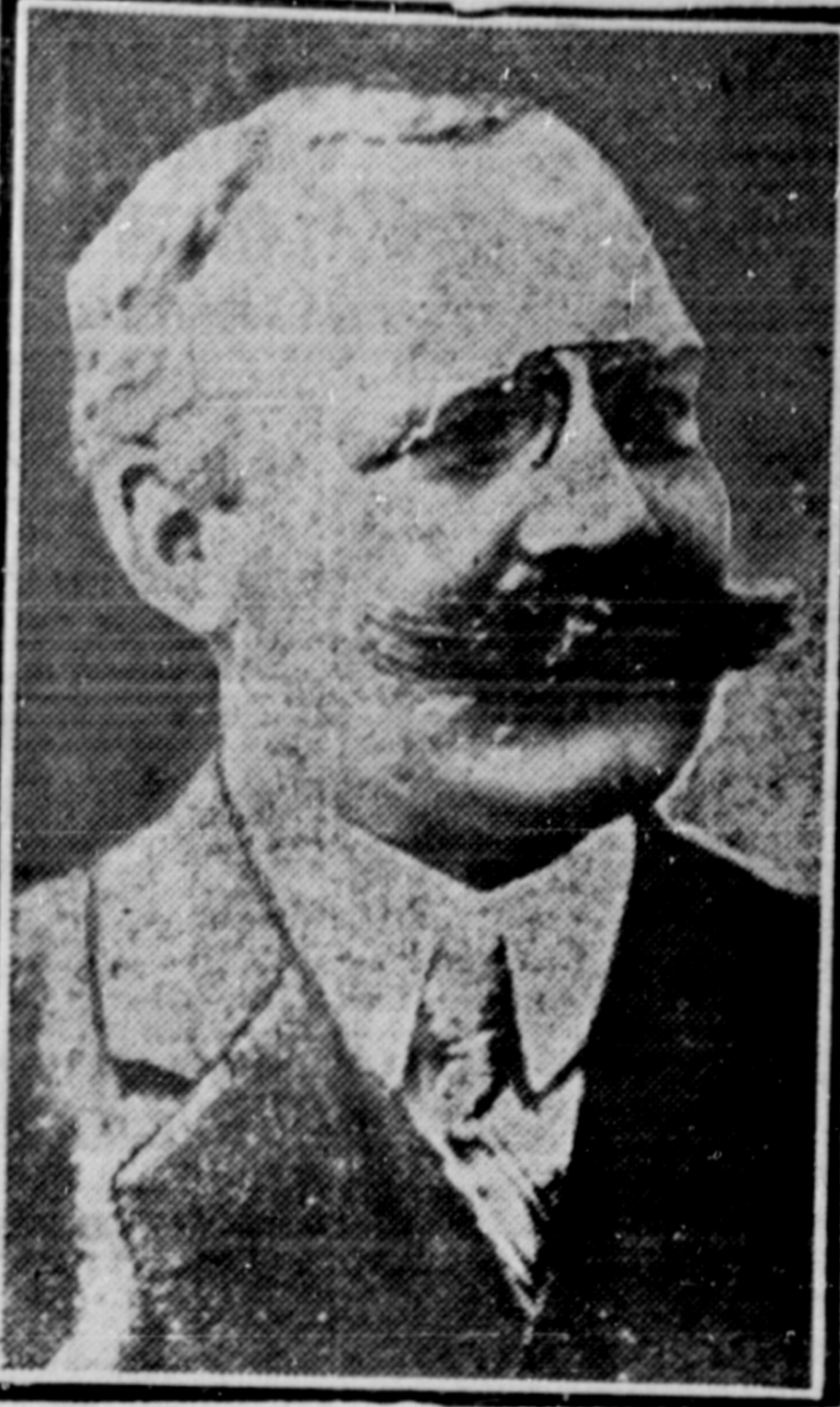
Ottawa, August 12.—Revisiting the home of his boyhood in the quaint old village of St. Lin, nestling in the shelter of the Laurentians, Sir Wilfrid Laurier received a great welcome from an assemblage of five thousand people. In response he gave to the great gathering an address the dominating theme of which was that of Canada's duty in the present war.

In the illuminated address presented to him by the parish reference was made to his "distinguished and unblemished career." It concluded with the prayer that he might long be spared in health and strength to further the great principles for which he always had stood, those of "justice, tolerance and liberty."

That gave the keynote to Sir Wilfrid in the stirring speech of a little over an hour in which he urged his compatriots of the province of Quebec to recognize that in the great war that Canada now was engaged in with the rest of the Empire and with old France these were the very principles which were at stake, and that to all Canadians equally
