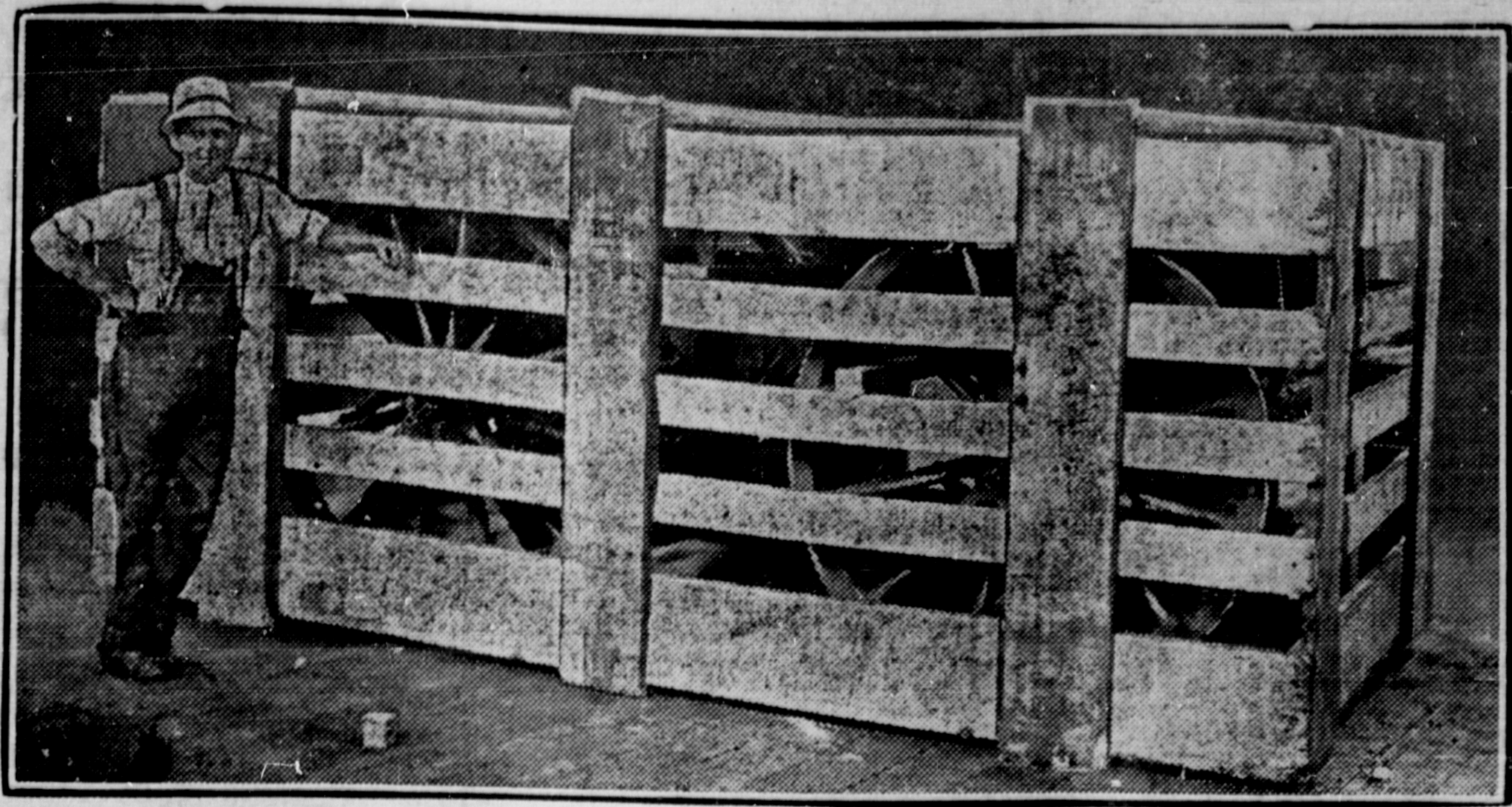

Efforts are being made to get the Dominion government to make a fishery display at the 1915 Fair. The value of the fishing industry to Prince Rupert is now fully recognized and Prince Rupert halibut has become a by-word in the east. The Dominion government is keenly interested in encouraging the greater consumption of fish products, and there is no doubt that a good fishery display at the Fair would aid materially the government publicity campaign in the Northern part of British Columbia.

Allin district has been heard from. They are sending an ex-

hibit to the Fair. They report an unexcelled year for successful agriculture, and while the furthest north, there is no doubt that they will give a good account of their district. Where does the growing belt of Northern B. C. end? Not in British Columbia at any rate. They can grow the stuff right up to the northern boundary and then on.

### 480 BANK OF COMMERCE BOYS ARE AT THE FRONT

A striking pamphlet has just been issued by the Canadian Bank of Commerce showing the extent of the "bit" which the staff of the bank is doing in the great war. It gives the names of the 480 men who have enlisted in the forces and also prints the bank's honor roll of 17 names of those who have already given their lives in the struggle. A most interesting portion of the publication is that which contains extracts from the bank officers at the front.—Toronto Globe.
