In the London Gazette of the 6th of August a notice appears cancelling the removal from the service of Captain H. S. Smart. Indian Army, which was notified in the Gazette of the 4th of June

It has since been ascertained that his action was due to his strong desire to join the force in France. It appears that he came to this country and enlisted in the name of Thomas Hardy into the 2nd Battalion Queen's Royal West Surry Regiment. While serving with this battalion as a private he was killed in action at Festubert on the 17th May, 1915, where he displayed such gallantry that he would have been granted the medal for distinguished conduct in the field had he survived.

In view of the special circumstances of the case, the Secretary of State for India, with the concurrence of the Army Council, decided to submit to His Majesty that the removal from the service of Captain Smart should be cancelled, and His Majesty has been graciously pleased to approve of this proposal.
