fecting infant industries, but that it was time for the government to step in and reduce the tariffs in certain lines where the manufacturers had got past infancy and were now millionaires and so arrogant that they thought they owned the country, body and soul. "It is time the tariff was brought to a minimum, simply to allow home manufacturers to compete with the foreigner," he said.

Referring to Professor Adam Shortt's remarks recently regarding the high rate of wages prevailing in the west, he said the professor was too prone to blame the labor situation. He felt that if the cost of living were reduced, labor could afford to come down proportionately. With a reduction in the tariff walls, he believed, the increased production would lower the cost of living, and a proportionate drop in wages would lead to Prince Rupert and the rest of the west becoming prosperous.

Ald. Casey congratulated the council on the success attending its efforts in celebrating the day
