#### THE GREAT ADVANCE

The long-looked-for advance on the western front has begun, and its success has far exceeded the expectations of the most sanguine.

Bilaire Belloc, the celebrated war correspondent, has been telling the people for months that nothing big could be expected in the west, until such time as the Russians deemed it advisable to strike in the east. On Saturday, the Russian offensive began, and, almost simultaneously, the British and French started the big move.

The capture of Lille is perhaps the most important gain so far, as this district will be able to relieve Britain of a good deal of strain in supplying coal and munitions. The most important feature of the advance is the fact that the territory gained has been consolidated.

With an ample supply of high explosives and other munitions, it is quite reasonable to expect that the Allies may advance for many miles yet, as the Germans are fully occupied on the eastern front, and, therefore, forced to split up their reinforcements between the two. It is, perhaps, too much to expect that the advance can be kept up steadily until the Huns are driven out of France and Belgium, but it is not outside the bounds of possibility. In any case, this great series of victories is the beginning of the end. There is much hard fighting still to be done, but nothing succeeds like success, and these big gains will prove a tremendous stimulus to recruiting, while the men in the munition factories will work with redoubled | When pressed part of the way
