## LUSITANIA MEMORIAL FUND TO ENDOW BEDS

The following letter from Mrs. Booth, wife of the chairman of the Cunard Steamship Co., Ltd. is self-explanatory:

Allerton Beeches, Liverpool, 6th September, 1915.

Dear sir:—I have raised a fund (from members of the Cunard Company only) to provide several motor ambulances for the front as a memorial to the 1,198 men, women and children, passengers and crew of the Lusitania, who lost their lives by the destruction of this ship on May 7th, 1915.

I received so many letters from England and America, from people not connected with the Cunard Company, who wish to take part in the memorial, that I am now raising a 2nd Memorial fund open to anyone in England and America.

This 2nd memorial will take the form of endowed beds, in the hospital near London, for the soldiers paralyzed or permanently disabled in the war.

### OF INTEREST TO CREDITORS OF CHRISTIANSEN & BRANDT

Mr. F. R. Stewart, who in August, 1909, was appointed by the creditors of the Christiansen & Brandt Co., real estate brokers, to supervise their business in the interests of the creditors, has appealed to the courts for direction what to do with a balance of \$13,471 left over from a sum of \$40,000 received from the sale of the Royal Block at Prince Rupert. Creditors to the extent of \$35,407 have been recognized by Mr. Stewart and others with claims totalling \$28,803 have threatened suit. Mr. Stewart has accordingly paid the balance into court and asks for directions.—Province.
