## WALL OF STEEL SURROUNDS THE DRIVEN BACK ON GERMAN EMPIRE

and Austrian Products-American Munitions Plant Burned.

Rome, Feb. 14.—The last gap in the steel wall surrounding the attacks by the Germans on the German Empire has been filled Allied positions in Champagne up by the Italian government forbidding the import of all German and Austrian products.

It is not believed that Germany will declare war upon Italy as a result of this action. The declaration followed a conference between the Italian premier and Premier Aristide Briand of the French government.

# GERMANS WERE FIVE OCCASIONS

Italy Prohibits Import of German Heavy Hun Losses in Sunday's Attacks in the Champagne District—Two Steamers Escape.
