WAR SITUATION

While the French and the British have done a tremendous amount of dogged fighting on the western front, the Russians in the east have provided the most spectacular warfare. Early in the war they made rapid progress into Galicia and the enemy seemed unable to stop them.

This great Russian advance is certain to have a tremendous effect upon the spirit of the German troops on the western front, if they are allowed to receive any of the reports, which is unlikely. In any case, the situation places Berlin in a desperate plight.
