THE PEOPLE WIN

The people of British Columbia have spoken, and in no uncertain voice. Thirty-seven Liberals have been elected to the Legislature and the probability is that the other ten will be Conservative.

The north is to be congratulated upon its returning three fighting members in T. D. Pattullo, Alex. M. Manson and F. H. Mobley. It is to be regretted that John McInnis has not been elected for Fort George, as he would have been an acquisition to the government in the strenuous business which lies before it.

The result cannot be taken as a party triumph, but as a glorious victory for the people of this province. H. C. Brewster and his supporters in the house have been elected by the people to carry on the business of the province for the people. Men of all shades of political opinion have put them there and it is safe to predict that the members of the new government will strive their utmost to show that the support is justified.

British Columbia is entering upon a new era of development. In a few months, the war will be over; thousands of men will return from Europe

and their energies must be directed along lines which will make for the rebuilding of this province and of its manhood and womanhood. There is a tremendous task facing H. C. Brewster and his ministers and the best augury of their accomplishing what they have set out to do is the fact that they realize very fully the measure of that task.

It has been said that the Liberals have posed as idealists in placing before the people their platform. The Brewster government will prove that it is composed of idealists; of men who have before them as a political chart a system of government which will work out for the benefit of British Columbia and Canada. This province needs men with ideals, and men who will strive to work out those ideals along practical lines.
