Violent Scenes at the Trial of the Cammorrists

PRIEST ON TRIAL

(Canadian Press Diasptch) Viterbo, Italy, May 8.—Sensational scenes marked the hearing of the Cammorrists trial on Saturday afternoon. Father Vit-torus urday afternoon. Father Vittorzi who is one of the prisoners, at the conclusion of the evidence of th informer Abbatemaggio, challen ged Vittorzi to swear on crucifix that he had not lied in hi evidence denouncing the Cammorra. Abbatemaggio put the crucifix to his lips and kissed it and swore he had told the truth. Vittorzi became livid with rage and cursed the informer in Latin. The court became uproarous, and by order of the Judges the carabinieri removed Father Vittorz from the room until his passion was subdued.
