Dr. Hirsch, an American, and Dr. Takamine, a Japanese who has done much research work in the United States, have gone to Japan to build a factory for the making of dyes which formerly were exclusively produced in Germany.

Premier Brewster will make a speech at the business' men's dinner in Vancouver tomorrow evening. It is a "get together" gathering, and the Premier will speak on co-operation in the development of the vast resources of British Columbia.

All Canadian males between the ages of 16 and 65 will be asked to answer a series of 24 questions shortly by the National Service Board. Two million postcards will be sent out bearing the queries.

The Niels Nielsen, the first of the big Norwegian steamers built in Seattle, had the misfortune to lose a propeller on her maiden voyage. She was last heard of 259 miles off Cape Flattery and all well, the weather being calm.

Capt. Frederick Mears, of the Alaskan Railway Commission, states that the railroad from Seward to Fairbanks will not be completed until 1920 or 1921, instead of 1918 as was originally announced. The construction work is much heavier than was expected.

The Seattle Construction and Drydock Company have been awarded the contract for the building of a scout cruiser which will cost \$4,975,000.

Shipping companies from around the Great Lakes are endeavoring to buy coast steamers for the growing trade on the

lakes. One company wants to purchase the Dolphin and Jefferson of the Alaska Steamship Company's fleet.

Charles Evans Hughes, the defeated candidate for the presidency of the United States, will resume the practice of law in New York on January 15th. His son, Charles E. Hughes, Junr., will be associated with him.
