#### SERVICE

After hearing Colonel Guthrie's magnificent speech on the war, one is impressed more strongly than ever of the necessity for National Service throughout Canada and the Empire. In the light of the facts brought out by this returned officer, it is apparent that, up to the present, in spite of all the magnificent efforts that have been put forth, Canada has been only playing at war. Canada has done much, but what has been done only goes to show how much remains to be accomplished. There is no call to give way to pessimism, but there is an instant demand for the husbanding of every dollar; of every resource, and the energy of every unit of Canada's manpower.

Enlistment for overseas service is a matter for each man to consider and decide upon A LOFTY MESSAGE according to the dictates of his own conscience, but there are many thousands of men throughout Canada who feel impelled to go, but who are held here by ties which they feel in duty bound not to break. If the National Service Board works along the right lines, it may solve many such problems and release for war service, either in Canada or overseas, thousands who are at present anxious but undecided as to their line of action.

What Canada needs today is a Lloyd George who will get down to business and put the whole Dominion on a war footing, not forgetting the enemy aliens in our midst, who would welcome the overthrow of Canada and the British Empire, and there are such still at large! and enjoying the freedom of Canadian institutions.
