Canada, like Britain, was unprepared for war, the declaration of August 4th, 1914, coming almost as a bolt from the blue. There was a praiseworthy and immediate offer of every assistance to Britain, and a feverish rush to equip a contingent of troops for overseas service. At that time, Canada did not realize the immensity of the task upon which she had entered, and it is questionable if more than a very small percentage of the people of the Dominion yet realize just how much has been accomplished, and, what is much more important, how much still remains to be done.

In Canada there has been much magnificent work done, but there has been little or no attempt made in the war of thorough organization. Recruiting has been carried on in a haphazard fashion with much overlapping and far more expense than was necessary. This is said in no tone of criticism, but simply to show the need for the new organiza-


