#### AMERICA'S PROTEST

Three thousand people attended the mass meeting in the Carnegie Hall, New York, to protest against the deportation of Belgian civilians into Germany to be forced to labor for the Germans, A strongly worded resolution was adopted, declaring that the reports in the press had not been contradicted and that investigation had shown that these were understated instead of exaggerated. The following is one of the clauses in the resolution, copies of which were ordered sent to all representatives of the German government who can be reached in the United States:

Resolved: "That we request the government of the United States to protest with all its force and earnestness against the detestation with which the American people regard these abuses; and to request ....e German government, in the name of all neutrals, to cease its policy of expatriation and slavery; and we pledge our utmost support to the Administration in whatever way it may conclude to act."

"Straight from the shoulder" speeches were made by Elihu Root, James M. Beck and other prominent citizens. Mr. Root declared that "if the civilized world of the twentieth century is willing to stand silent in the face of what Germany is now doing in Belgium, then the civilization of this century is worse than the savagery which marked the Roman Era."

This is the right kind of peace talk and well worthy of the nation which had its own battle to fight against slavery. Many in this great mass meeting must have thought of Lincoln and what he would have






