ALLIED TERMS

The Entente Powers have not submitted their peace terms to Germany but they have plainly told Washington upon what basis they will be prepared to consider a settlement. It is asserted that President Wilson knows the terms which Germany is prepared to offer, and, if this is so, and it is not unlikely, then Washington is now aware as to the possibility of an early peace conference. It is very unlikely that any further information will be divulged until Ambassador Gerard has had another conference with the German diplomats but it is clear that the matter is not ended, provided Germany is really sincere in her desire to discuss a settlement.

The telegraphic despatches give the barest outline of the Allied demands and there are several important points not mentioned, for instance, the situation in the Dardanelles. 
