

#### HEALTHY SOLDIERS

The Seattle P.-I. has the following to say in regard to a report on the health of the soldiers in the trenches. The P.-I. attributes their immunity from disease to the fact that they are so constantly in the fresh air. Undoubtedly this is to a large extent responsible for the splendid health of the soldiers, but it is not unlikely that a great deal of their power to resist disease is the result of their attitude of mind. The following is the P.-I. article:-

Notwithstanding all that has been said about the squalor and discomfort of life in the trenches at the battle front, the remarkable fact appears, according to all medical testimony, that the health conditions of the men averages far better than is the case with those at home and even better than among men of the same class and the same physical equipment in the days of peace.


