LONE STAR PROPERTY WORKED UNDER BOND

M. T. Watt left Smithers for Edmonton Saturday night for a few weeks. He closed a deal on the Lone Star group and has put a number of men to work on it.

This property is on Hudson Bay mountain just up a short distance from Lake Kathlyn. It was located and partially developed by Jennings Bros. and they are in charge of the new work.

Jennings Bros. had done four hundred feet of underground work. They have a vein twenty one feet wide which is mineralized all across. It is low grade, and requires considerable development before determining upon the installation of a plant for treating the ore. An engineer is expected shortly to sample the vein and advise upon the treatment of the ore and the development. In the meantime a hundred feet of tunnel will be driven and this will give a hundred feet of depth.

The Lone Star Mining Co. will operate under a B. C. charter. Capital is a million dollars with a million shares. The ore is silver lead. Omineca Herald.
