was organized in 1912, it was estimated that in case of war the entire personnel would have to be renewed every six months—that that period would represent the average life of an airman in active service. In the first five months of the present war, however, during which the corps was almost continuously engaged in scouting and raiding expeditions, the total loss was six airmen killed by the enemy, five killed accidentally, five wounded, and five missing or prisoners, a total disablement of less than three per cent of the airmen on active service.
