BOB'S EVIDENCE

Bob Rogers' chickens are coming home to roost, as chickens will, and it is particularly unfortunate for Sir Robert Borden that he allowed himself to be forced to admit the "election wizard" of Manitoba to his cabinet.

The report of Mr. Justice Galt regarding the kind of evidence given by Mr. Rogers before the commission of enquiry into the construction of the Manitoba Agricultural College requires little comment. It speaks for itself. The worthy "Bob" has got himself into several political "scrapes" but he is now in a very awkward predicament.
