In the House on Wednesday he tried to show that the reason why the Ottawa Citizen criticised him so severely in regard to his connection with the Manitoba Agricultural College building was that the owners of the paper had failed to persuade him to buy a post-office site in Montrea!. Be the actions of the newspaper proprietors what they may, and "Bob" in the past has not shown any great resentment towards buying post-office sites, the Honorable Robert cannot get away from the report brought in by the investigation committee along with which Mr. Justice Galt sent a communication stating that he could place no credence in the evidence of the Minister of Public Works of the Borden government.
