

## NEW BRUNSWICK ELECTION

As in other parts of Canada the tide of Liberalism has swept over New Brunswick. The fair province by the sea has been in the hands of the Conservative party for the last nine years or so. That they were no longer required to administer the affairs of the people was shown very plainly at this election. The pariiamentary representation of New Brunswick was in some respects similar to that of British Columbia before this last election. The Liberals in the house were very few in New Brunswick, while in British Columbia we had none. According to our advices, on the first day's voting the Liberals gaintd twenty seats. There are only forty-eight constituencies altogether. When we see the Liberal principles being voted for by the majority of the electorate in such widely separated provinces, where conditions are so dissimilar, the question naturally arises in our minds, "Is not Toryism becoming obsolete?" 
