## NEY AUSTRIAN TRICK

London, March 13,-Official annonncement was made here today that Austria-Hungary has issued a proclamation to the Albanians, stating that it has granted autonomy to Albania under its protection.

Influential Albanians have published from Saloniki, the statement says, a protest, saying the Austrian measure is useless because it is directed toward a country which, already independent, has declared war on the enemies of the Entente. The purpose of the Vienna government in issuing this proclamation, the statement adds, obviously is to justify the levy of men for its armies.

After the occupation of Serbia and Montenegro by troops of the Central Powers all of Albania was taken over with the exception of the section in the south below Avlona, which still is held by the Italians, Essad Pasha, Provisional President of Albania, served with the Turkish army early in the war, but later left it and declared war on the Central Powers, taking a force of Albanians under his command to Saloniki, where it joined the Entente army.
