

ALMOST A "TRIUMPH"

The apostles of submarine frightfulness have almost reached the summit of their ambition, says the Times. They have sunk a British hospital ship, the Asturias, but as there were no sick or wounded on board a measure of disappointment will modify the jubilation among the Huns the announcement from Berlin will produce. There probably will be no formal services in Berlin and Hamburg, such as those which marked the "signal success" against the Lusitania. The commander's reward will be an Iron Cross of subordinate degree only. Now, if he had sunk the Asturias before she had landed her 900 patients, as he was instructed to do if possible, he would have qualified for a wooden statue to be stuck full of iron nails, in true primitive Hun fashion,
