## THE ORE REFINERY

Dr. Wilson, the eminent geologist, who has been working in conjunction with the Imperial Munitions Board, in his report to that body states that the most suitable location for the reduction and refining of copper, lead, zinc and other ores is one of two places on the Pacific coast. While the names of these locations are not mentioned, it may quite readily be assumed, and properly so, that one of the two is Prince Rupert. On account of its strategic geographic situation, and the fact that within a radius of two hundred miles are vast resources of these minerals, the fact of the suitability of Prince Rupert as the site for the proposed reduction wroks and refinery cannot be gainsaid.

The successful operation of such mines as those of the Granby Company, Rocher de Boule, at Hazelton, Surf Inlet mine on Princess Royal Island, the Dolly Varden at Alice Arm, and many others now undergoing the process of development, this only needs to be pointed out to prove the contention.

At a meeting of the Board of Trade in the city this week, the following resolutions were endorsed, which fully bear out these remarks:




