FOOD DICTATOR FOR THE DOMINION

Winnipeg, May 26.—The Telegram's Ottawa correspondent writes: "A food controller for Canada probably will be appointed by the Government this week. The whole question will be discussed by the Cabinet within the next few days and it is understood the majority of the ministers favor the appointment of one man with full authority to deal with the question. He will act in conjunction with Herbert C. Hoover, former chairman of the Belgian Relief Commission, whom President Wilson has announced he has selected to become Food Controller in the United States.

Wide Powers.
Ottawa, May 26.—According to the Ottawa Citizen, the controller of food supplies whom the Government intends to appoint will have very wide powers. He will be vested with authority to limit the amount of food products which may be kept in storage and also to compel, whenever he deems it necessary, the distribution and marketing of foodstuffs. The regulation or fixing of prices may be a subsequent development. It will not be applied until restricted marketing has been tried and its effects shown in preventing abnormal prices of food.

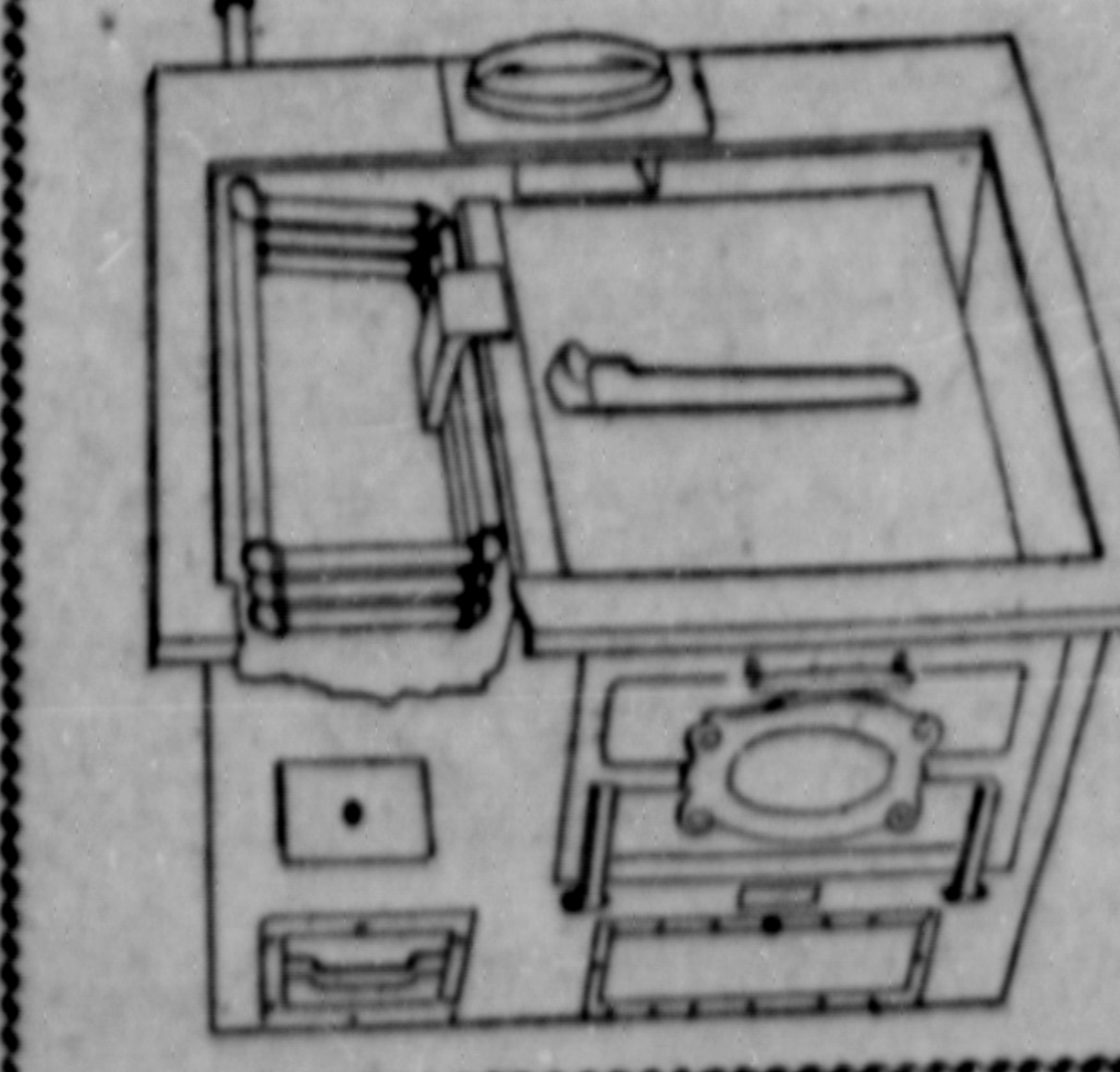
