GREATEST POWER ENTERPRISE IN THE WORLD .- The diagram on the left shows the generating and distributing stations of the Ontario Power Company's plant at Niagara Falls, just purchased by the Hydro-Electric Commission for \$22,600,000. At the generating station on the brink of the Niagara River below the Horseshoe Falls, 160,000 h.p. is developed. From the distributing station on the hill,100,000 h. p. is turned over to the Hydro-Electric Commission. which distributes it over 1,050 miles of line in Ontario, while the balance of 60,000 h.p. is exported to the Niagara Lockport and Ontario Power Co., which is distributed through Western and Central New York.
