The British casualties so far in the war now reaches fifteen thousand. The Allies are again bombarding Cattara. Fifteen thousand men per day enlist for the front in Britain.

New York—The British embassy at New York in a review says the Allies now have unchallenged command of the seas.

The Germans have evacuated Lille. There has been no main trial of strength in France in the last five days. The British are refitting and consolidating their units.
