Henderson immediately leaped over his counter and knocked the man flat, later calling the North Vancouver police and giving Dierssen in charge. Dierssen was brought over to Vancouver, turned over to the military authorities, who turned him over to the city police, only to be released. The North Vancouver police said there was no charge laid in the North Vancouver police Court and they have no warrant for his arrest.

### REPRISALS ARE TO BE MADE AGAINST ENEMY

Ottawa, May 6.—The attempt made by three German prisoners in Fort Henry barracks, Kingston, to injure the guards and escape from the camp for interns may have international developments. The decision of the supreme military court in Germany in imposing a sentence of death upon Private W. Lonsdale, of Leeds, England, for attacking a German non-commissioned officer at the military prison camp at Doebritz has aroused the military authorities here. It is claimed that if the sentence is carried out upon Private Lonsdale that a court-martial will be held in Canada and a similar sentence meted out to the German prisoners.

This can be done under military law, which is the only law in vogue where prisoners of war are concerned. Among the German prisoners is a well known German officer holding the rank of count in the German Empire, and an owner of large properties in the West. It is claimed that he was the ringleader in the attack upon the guards.

**Deliberate Attempt.**  
In Private William Lonsdale's case the evidence goes to show that he only struck the non-commissioned officer under extreme provocation, while in the case of the prisoners at Fort Henry barracks a deliberate attempt was made without the slightest provocation on the part of the military authorities to do away with the guards and escape from the prison.

It is considered here by the military authorities that it is about time the Germans were taught that Germany is not the only country in which prisoners of war are confined. If Private William Lonsdale receives the death penalty for defending himself under provocation from German tyranny, it is claimed here by the military authorities that surely nothing less than the death penalty could be measured out to men who without the slightest provocation at all made an attempt upon their guards.

General Hughes stated positively that if Private Lonsdale is shot by the Germans there will be reprisals in Canada and the victims will be the mutinous German prisoners at Kingston, Ont.
