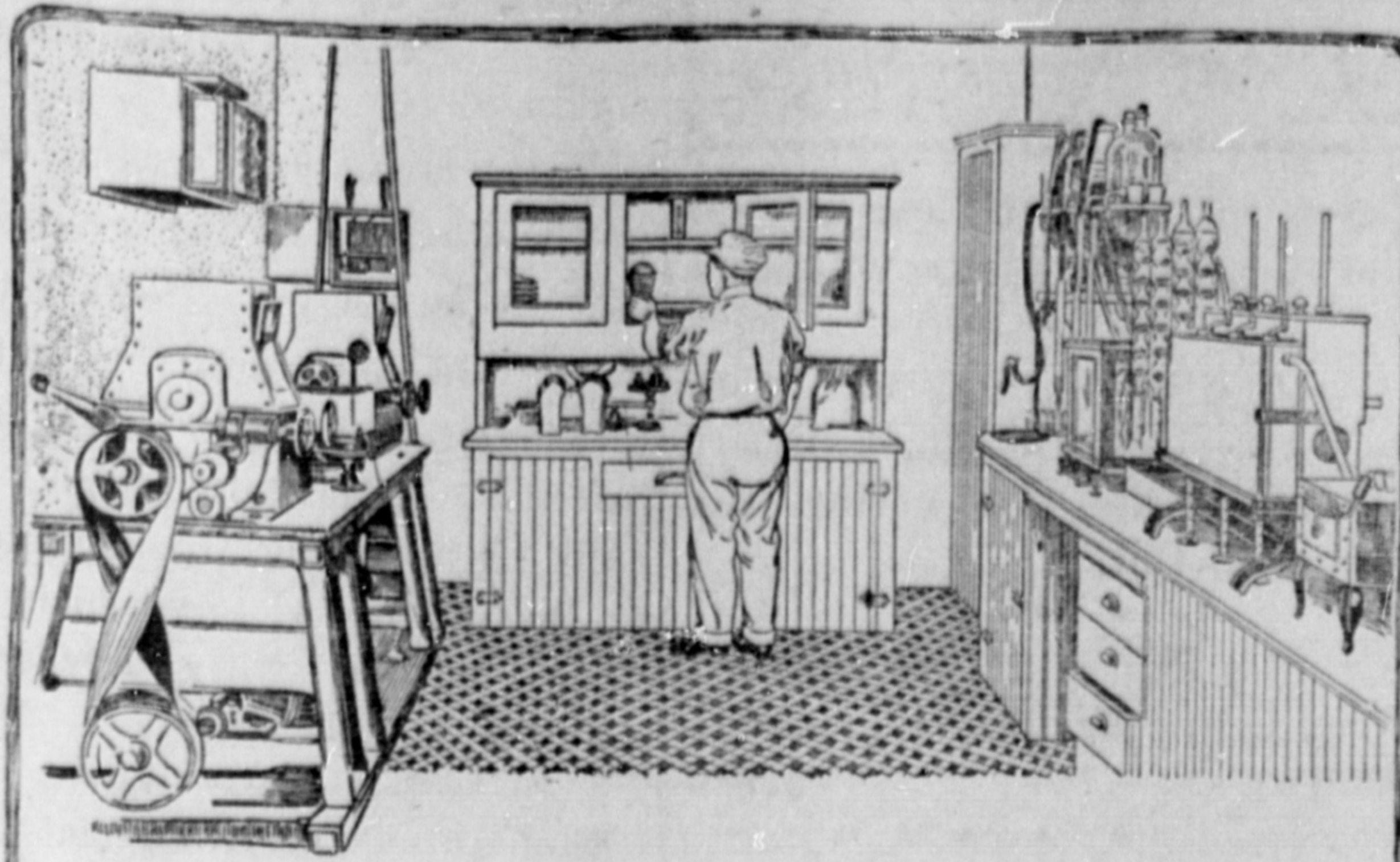
# FORD WILL BUILD NO SUBMARINES

New York, Sept. 26.—Henry Ford spent two hours at the navy yard today inspecting submarines and the latest forms of marine machinery. At the conclusion of his trip the manufacturer announced he did not expect to build any submarines in the near future and that he was still a strong peace advocate.

"I was very much interested in all I saw," said Mr. Ford, who was accompanied by his son, Edsel Ford. They were met at the entrance to the navy yard by Lieutenant Commander R. T. Craft, aide of Rear-Admiral Nathaniel R. Usher, commandant. The Ford party was shown through various departments and taken into the submarine K-5 by Lieut. Ralph C. Grady, the commander. Every detail of the craft was explained to the manufacturer, but it was not submerged. He also inspected two other submarines equipped with nickel batteries, recently invented by Thomas A. Edison.

Mr. Ford was insistent that an efficient under-sea-craft could be built at one-sixteenth the cost of the present vessels. When he was asked how many of them he would suggest building he replied "none."
