HALIBUT TROUBLE RECOUNTED IN SENATE

Washington, Aug. 27.—Senator Jones, in the debate on the revenue bill yesterday, told the Senate all about the troubles of the halibut trade in the North Pacific. He presented the records of orders-in-council and other discriminatory legislation enacted by Canada to build up Canadian commerce in halibut, at the expense of the American industry, and contrasted this with the acts and attitude of this administration.

He emphasized the fact that a protest by Britain had held up for weeks American legislation calculated merely to equalize conditions. He showed that Canadian orders-in-council which prohibit shipments other than by rail out of Prince Rupert, permitted Canadian fishermen to sell their catch at Prince Rupert at from 25 to 30 per cent. better prices than American fishermen.
