"It is hard to realize how the Emperor, who enjoyed a popularity unexampled in our epoch, suffers in his pride. He alone perhaps in Germany knows the whole truth, since he alone has in his possession the elements for forming a judgment in the situation as a whole.

"Once he tried to initiate peace negotiations and failed. To try again would be to admit and proclaim to the world, but above all to the German people, which he fears most, Germany's real situation. If the Allies solemnly declared, as they did with Napoleon in 1815, that they would refuse to treat for peace with the Hohenzollern it would be a knockout blow.
