TB Groups Launch Drive Against Killer

Tuberculosis associations in 230 communities of Canada launched their annual drive for funds by sale of Christmas seals this week.

Money from these annual campaigns, held in Canada at the same time as a similar drive in the United States, is spent by the various committees on a variety of preventative measures, including education programs and mass x-ray surveys to find tuberculosis cases in the early stages when they are most easily treated.

The double-barred cross on this year's Christmas seal marks the 50th anniversary of the choice of this symbol by an international conference of many countries in Berlin.
