"Wild scenes of angry disorder which threatened at one time to terminate in a riot, swept Parliament tonight. Amid shouts of 'Call in the police!' and a tumult and angry roar above which no words could be heard, Sir Thomas White and Hon. Rodolphe Lemieux were both on their feet. quivering with passion, and gesticulating at one another and at Deputy Speaker Rainville. A moment late, Hon. William Pugsley, backed by Opposition cheering and Government booting, was out in the middle of the floor, facing the manifestly nervous Deputy Speaker, and demanding recognition from the Chair for Mr. L. J. Gauthier (St. Hyacinthe), who was endeavoring to address the House
