London, Oct. 20 .- Reuter's correspondent on the British front in France and Belgium telegraphs the following:-

"The weather cleared up today, renewing opportunities for aerial activity. Nevertheless, the battlefront is a vast weltering panorama of mud islets and countless green shell holes.

"A remarkable instance of the most cool individual daring is being told of an officer who become enraged because a nest of German snipers was firing on British stretcher-bearers, although enemy stretcher-bearers were working alongside for a considerable time unmolested. After a number of British stretcher-bearers had been shot down, the officer, carrying a Red Cross flag, walked boldly to the snipers' hiding place and proceeded in the most vigorous German to tell the snipers what he ! thought of them and their barbarity. 
