

IN THE LETTER BOX

Dear News:—At the recent organization meeting held in the Empress Theatre in this city in the interests of Lt.-Col. Peck, the Rev. Canon Rix, in the course of his remarks, frankly admitted there was a time when he felt that Mr. Stork, the Liberal candidate, had received a raw deal in this city. The Rev. gentleman might have taken the public a little further into his confidence and have informed them who the men are that were responsible for the dirty work in putting through the deal referred to, and which candidate they are supporting in this election, instead of endeavoring to cast the stigma of disloyalty upon the Liberal candidate for being at home while Lt.-Col. Peck, the win the war candidate, (so-called) is fighting on the fields of Europe to uphold the principles which we all, as Canadians, cherish.

While I, personally, do not approve of the course which Lt.-Col. Peck has pursued, in allowing his name to be put in nomination in this present campaign and cannot support him, it is not my intention to criticize his action, nor my wish to detract in any way from the honors he has won. However, it does seem to me, Mr. Editor, it could not humanly be expected that any man with red blood in his veins would be tearing his hair to get back into uniform under an administration having at its head a man who would allow such a raw deal to be put through, under the strongest protest.

Rev. Canon Rix seems to have overlooked the fact that the raw deal referred to was finally consummated on the 9th day of May, 1914, before there was any war or rumor of war, when no emergency existed for a local corps in this city, and that he was one of the men taking a commission in the new corps. A glance at the militia lists of the Dominion will prove the truth of this statement.

It would seem to me far more becoming to the Rev. gentleman were he to devote his spare time to seeing that the brave boys in our city, who will very shortly be called to the colors, receive some preliminary military training prior to being drafted into service, rather than continue the bitter fight against the Liberal Candidate which was begun in January, 1913.
