### BIG BUSINESS

Among the first of the results of the return to power of the Union Government is the increase in the railway freight rates. According to all accounts, there exists extreme dissatisfaction among the Western provinces over this deal, and most of the dissatisfaction is being expressed in the prairie provinces. These are the provinces which did so much to elect the Union Government, and already they are not pleased with its doings. They know that any government headed by Sir Robert Borden, and having in its personnel men like Sir George Foster and particularly with a man like Tom White as minister of finance, would be purely and simply a government representing Big Business. Any government with these men at the head of it means a government of Big Business for Big Business.
