THE SUPREME WAR COUNCIL

At Versailles, that place of so many historic memories for France and for Europe, the representatives of all the allies have been conferring for the past few days, talking over the initial feelers for peace, which have been thrown out from Germany and Austria-Hungary, and arising out of the discussion of peace terms which has already taken place at Brest-Litovsk. The allies can find no approximation in these speeches to the terms already put forward by themselves. The conditions of peace, which will be agreeable to the allies are already well known. Germany knows what they are, and her rulers like them not. Austria-Hungary knows what they are, and that proudest of European courts cannot see any great satisfaction in them. The peace of the world, and the welfare of the peoples of these respective countries, and of all poples on the globe for that matter, are, however, interested to a great degree, whether they admit it or not. They are interested, or ought to be, in the maintainence of peace, and of the peaceful evolution of society. The ideals of freedom as seen by the allies and as imagined by Germany are totally different.
