#### PROGRESS, OR NO PROGRESS

The telegraphic communications which have passed between the Dominion Government Fisheries Department and this city within the last day or two, which we published yesterday, on the question of whether or no the salmon fishermen may use gas boats in the pursuit of their calling, adumbrates in some degree the action which the government will take shortly in the revision of the fishery regulations, obtaining in District No. 2, in which Prince Rupert is situat-

At present, the use of gas boats in fishing for salmon by gill nets on the Skeena river is forbidden, under the fishery regulations. When it is remembered that these regulations were instituted for the protection of the salmon, the ordinary reader, without any special knowledge of fishing may well wonder what difference it would make to the fish what kind of boat the fishermen were in when they cast their nets. It would make no difference at all to the fish, but it would make a very great deal of difference to the fishermen. Anyone who has visited the canneries, and has seen the boat which is the average of those supplied to the fishermen by the canneries might well wonder that these boats are even manned at all, especially in such a swiftly flowing river
