Mr. Bowser had some considerable criticism to offer regarding the powers taken by the Minister. Under the new provisions, the government takes the power to take out Spruce logs wherever they are, if the owner of the timber limit will not do so himself. Mr. Bowser considered that the Legislature should go slowly in taking property from anyone.
