



ALLIES HAVE PERFECT CONFIDENCE IN JAPAN

London, March 15.—Mr. Arthur Balfour, speaking in the House of Commons upon the situation in the East, expressed his perfect confidence in the absolute loyalty of Japan in the carrying out of any decision which might be reached. He declared that no distinction can be drawn between Japan and other of the allies.

ONE SAMMY BEATS OFF FORTY GERMANS

With the United States Army in France, March 15.—A lone American sentry this morning attacked an enemy patrol of about forty men, some of whom had stealthily entered the advanced American trench. He drove them off, killing the leader and wounding others. The sentry saw the patrol advancing and looked on as the Germans began to drop cautiously. They were not quick enough, however, for the sentry's bullets caught some of them. A small enemy patrol of four men then joined in the fray, and assisted to speed the parting guests, with hand grenades.

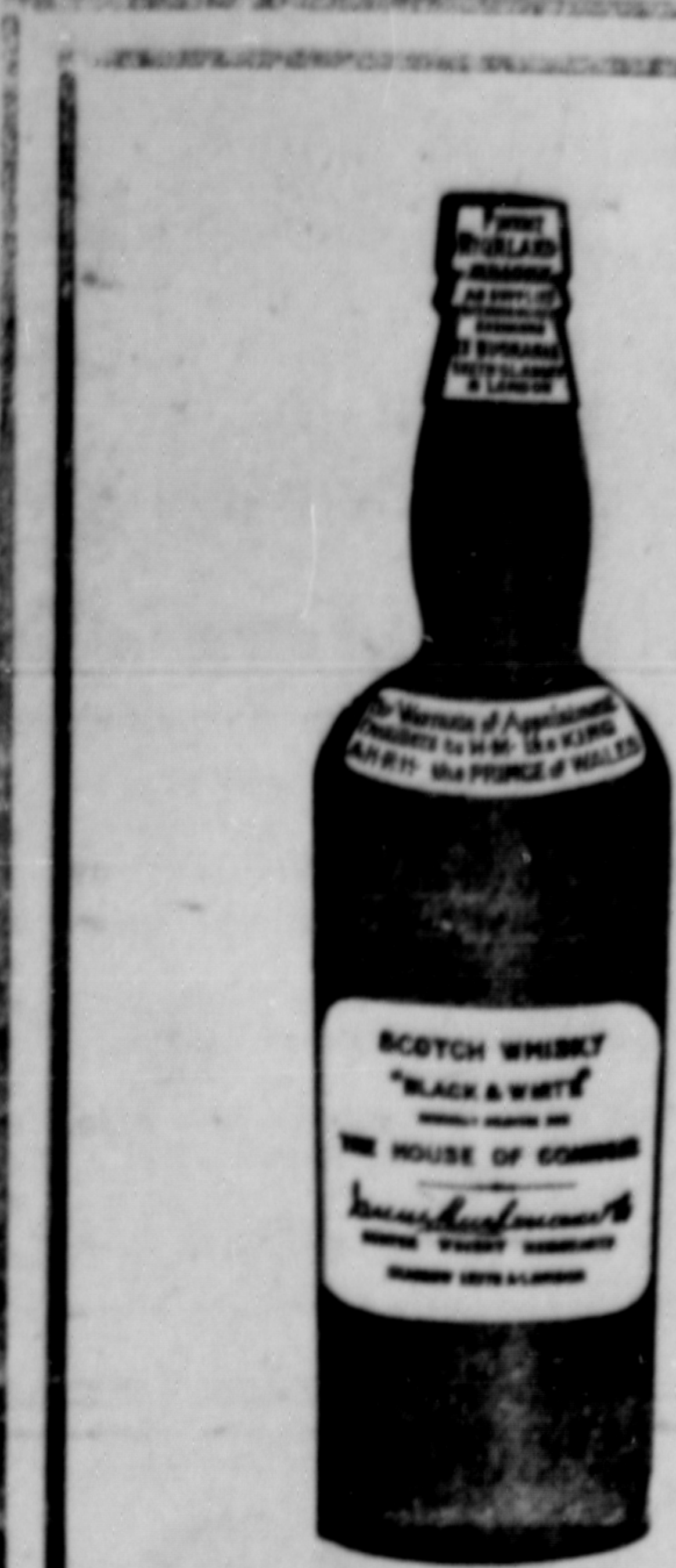
