London, April 10. - Percival Phillips, war correspondent at the front, says in the Daily Express: "I have heard, although not officially, interesting details of the German long-range gun which has been bombarding Paris. The existence of this gun had not been a secret long before the big battle began, and it is rumored the Germans made successful experiments of a new high velocity weapon firing a freak shell, capable of creating a new record distance.

"It seems the gun that has been bombarding Paris is about 79 feet long, with a shell of about 8 or 9 inches, fitted with a false cap and a kind of elongated nose, giving it an extreme length, just under


