## SECRET OF LONG-RANGE GERMAN GUN REVEALED BY U. S. CORRESPONDENT

London, April 10. — Percival Phillips, war correspondent at the front, says in the Daily Express: "I have heard, although not officially, interesting details of the German long-range gun which has been bombarding Paris. The existence of this gun had not been a secret long before the big battle began, and it is rumored the Germans made successful experiments of a new high velocity weapon firing a freak shell, capable of creating a new record distance."

"It seems the gun that has been bombarding Paris is about 79 feet long, with a shell of about 8 or 9 inches, fitted with a false cap and a kind of elongated nose, giving it an extreme length, just under 5 feet."

"The secret of the gun appears to be in the distribution of the weight in the shell, which gives steadiness and enables it to travel a long distance."

## ALLIED LOSSES WERE AMAZINGLY SMALL

London, April 10. — It is reckoned that the Germans had 192 divisions on the west front in all, and that of them he sent 100 into the attack. Of these, between forty and fifty were so badly mauled that they were withdrawn to refit. As the Germans generally relieve a division after it has suffered 5,000 casualties, it is held that the total German losses may be estimated conservatively at from 250,000 to 300,000.

It is admitted that in the first onslaught, when the men in the first line of outposts were holding the enemy masses up and sacrificing themselves deliberately, many allied units suffered heavily but since then the action has been fought in such a way as to minimize the casualties greatly. An exact count has been kept, and your correspondent is informed from a competent source that the allied losses are quite amazingly low "when all things are considered."

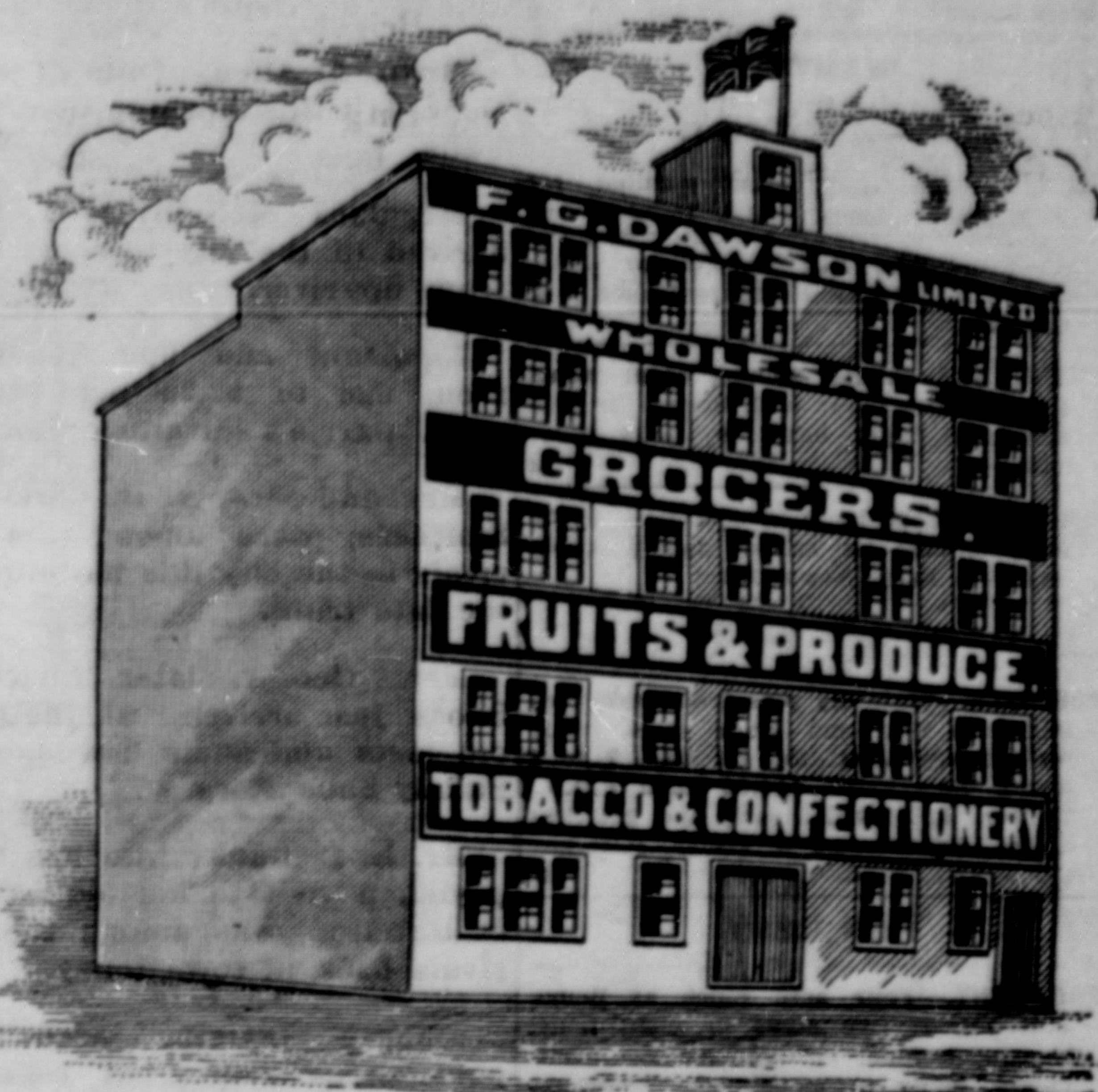
