#### THE RED TRIANGLE

To those who are interested in the development of the nation's manhood, it must be a source of great satisfaction to observe the efficient service conducted among the Canadian Expeditionary and home service forces by the Young Men's Christian Association. So important has become the work of the "Y" secretaries and of such effect is their influence upon the morale of the men, that everywhere, in all warring nations, the khaki officials of the international organization are received with open arms and every possible facility is provided for the carrying on of the work. Army and navy officers have been very generous in writing unsolicited letters telling of the faithful service rendered by the "Y" officers. and it was with becoming modesty that Captain Pearson referred to the scope of the work now being carried on, particularly overseas, at his meeting two nights ago. The accounts from the boys themselves written both on this side and overseas, are perhaps the truest tests of the efficiency and usefulness of the Y. M. C. A. operations among the soldiers, and those which have been received by the Association and others are certainly not damnatory with faint praise.

That there is a voluntary institution of this kind extending comfort, so far as they are able, to the men who are fighting for us, is the greatest reason for its continued support.
