Amsterdam, May 22.—The Berlin newspapers gave indications that the prospect of new thrones in the East for German princts has stirred German court circles as seldom, if ever, before. The Socialist newspaper, Vorwaerts says that agents from the courts are travelling hither and thiher in tffors to make propaganda for or against tht various families to which the honors might fall.

This scramble for thrones, Vorwaerts fears, may endanger German unity. It therefore urges, probably in a spirit of irony, that a compromise be effected by filling the thrones with Turkish princes.




