

TRAIL SMELTER ORE SHIPMENTS

In point of tonnage for ore received at the Trail smelter the year, 1917 and 1918 are running neck and neck-each year for the seven expired months showing a few tons over 200,000. The actual figures are 200,237 tons received in seven months for 1917 and 200,145 received for the same period in 1918. Last year was supposed to be one of the most prosperous years in Trail, while at present business is just running along normally, as indicated by the ore tonnage receipts, the barometer which really counts in Trail.

July for this year shows an increase in ore and concentrates received here of nearly 3,000 tons over June, and ore from a number of mines has been coming in quite steadily all this month. With general conditions more settled, it would appear that this gradual increase should continue from this on. Of course, the totals would have been much larger had the Rossland goldcopper mines continued shipping this year as usual.


