Several Dead In Heat Wave

Torrid Weather Extends Throughout East and Middle West

CHICAGO, July 14.—Several deaths and numerous prostrations were reported yesterday from a heat wave extending through the east and middle west.

The temperature reached a maximum of 96 at 4 o'clock yesterday afternoon here, the low for the day being 74. An unidentified man about 60 years of age dropped dead in the street. A change in wind last evening gave promise of a change.

New York had a maximum of 88 and minimum of 66 while in New Orleans the temperature ranged from 80 to 98 above.

NEW POSTAGE STAMPS OUT

Special Designs in 3c, 5c and 13c Denominations in Connection With Economic Conference

New Canadian postage stamps issued in connection with the holding of the Imperial economic confer-

ence in Ottawa were being sold at the local Post Office yesterday and created considerable interest.

The Ottawa conference stamps are being offered in three denominations—3c, bearing the King's head, and somewhat like the old English penny stamps; 5c, bearing a picture of the Prince of Wales, and 13c, with a special design.

Stamp collectors will be interested in these stamps of which it is understood only a limited number will be issued.

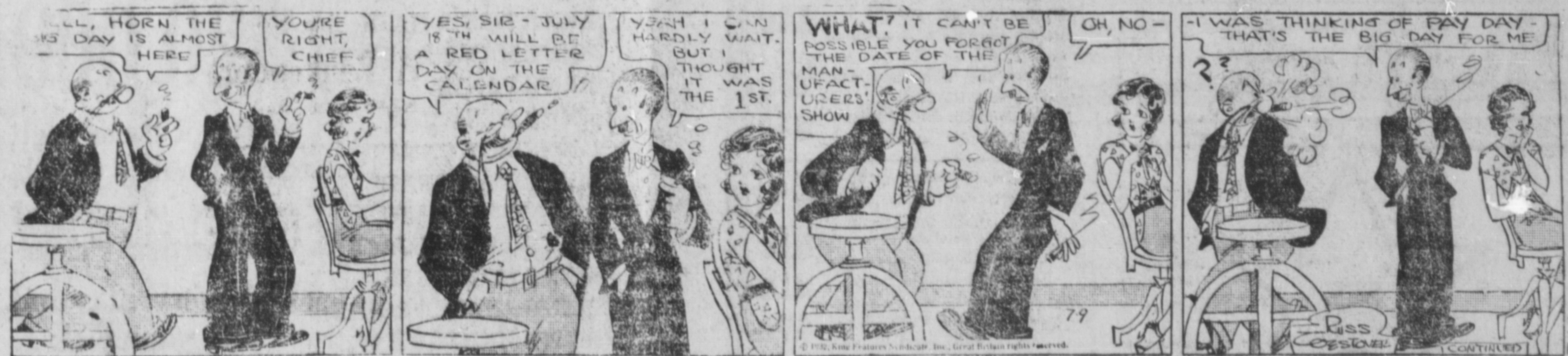
