

PRICES CURRENT IN CITY STORES TODAY

Winter Fruits are Becoming More
Plentiful—Soft Fruits Now
Practically Finished for
Another Year.

The approach of the winter season is made evident in the store displays these days. The piles of soft and perishable fruits are decreasing and the change from even four weeks ago is most evident. There is only an odd peach or two being shown, while the bright colors of the earlier varieties of apples are becoming more varied. Wealthies are being shown from \$2.25 to \$3; Macintosh reds and Wagners at \$3.75, and Jonathans at \$4.00.

A new line in preserving pears is in today. These are of the "Louis Bowne" variety and they look well. There are also some fine looking Queen Charlotte Island potatoes selling at \$2.50 per sack. These are red spuds, while there is expected in a day or two a carload of Terrace potatoes. These are white potatoes and ought to be worth around \$2.75 per sack, delivered. In ton lots they will sell at \$48.00.

A large shipment of cabbage for making sauerkraut is expected to arrive any day, and should sell at about 4c. Californian walnuts are also showing at 45c per lb., but are still scarce. Cluster raisins, too, have arrived. Canned pineapple, however, seems to be the scarcest commodity meantime. Notwithstanding the scarcity of cargo space, Keillers, of Dundee, and Cross & Blackwell jams and jellies are still being offered in some of the shops.
