SYNOPSIS OF LAND ACT AMENDMENT

Pre-emption now confined to surveyed Records will be granted covering only land suitable for agricultural purposes Partnership pre-emptions abolished but parties of not more than four may arrange for adjacent pre-emptions, with joint residence, but each making neces sary improvements on respective claims five years and make improvements value of \$10 per acre, including clearing

fore receiving Crown Grant. less than 3 years, and has made proportionate improvements, he may, because intermediate certificate of improvement

Records without permanent residence improvements to extent of \$300 per ansame will operate as forfeiture. Title less than 5 years, with improvements o and cultivated, and residence

Pre-emptor holding Crown Grant may record another pre-emption, if he reland in conjunction with his farm, without actual occupation, proresidence maintained on Crown granted

Unsurveyed areas, not exceeding 20 acres, may be leased as homesites; title to be obtained after fulfilling restdential and improvement conditions. For grazing and industrial purposes, areas exceeding 640 acres may be leased by one person or company.

PRE-EMPTORS' FREE GRANTS ACT. The scope of this Act is enlarged to with His Majesty's Forces. The time within which the heirs or devisees of a deceased pre-emptor may apply title under this Act is extended from one year from the death of such person as formerly, until one year after the conclusion of the present war. This privilege is also made retroactive.

TOWNSITE PROPERTY ALLOTMENT

Provision is made for the grant to ments to Purchase from the Crown of such proportion of the land, if divisible, as the payments already made wi cover in proportion to the sale price of holding such Agreements may group their interests and apply for a proporconsidered advisable to divide the land tionate allotment, an allotment of land of equal value selected from available Crown lands in the locality may be made. These allotments are conditional upon payment of all taxes due rights of persons to whom the purchaser from the Crown has agreed to sell are also protected. The decision of the Minister of Lands adjustment of a proportionate allotment is final. The time for making application for these allotments is limited to the 1st day of May, 1919. Any application made after this date will not be considered. These allotments apply to town lots and lands of the Crown sold at public auction.
