## LUMBER MILLS ARE CURTAILING OUTPUT

At a conference in Vancouver recently the mill owners of this section of British Columbia decided to curtail their output by 20 per cent. The lumbermen have adopted this course owing to a general falling off in the business. At the present time there is practically no market on the prairies for coast lumber and the embargo to the United States has also had its effect with the result that local mills are finding themselves with large stocks on hand. This decision has already gone into effect at some of the mills, while it is expected that fifty per cent. or more of the mills on the lower mainland and Vancouver Island will be affected by it. The length of time during which this curtailment will be effective is not definitely known, depending upon the general conditions of the lumber market. A revival in this market is, however, looked for in the early part of next year or the spring.
