AMERICAN WOUNDED IGNORED AIR RAIDERS

Refused to Leave Bombed Hospital Until Nurses Compelled Them To Go Into Dugouts.

With the American Army Northwest of Verdun, Nov. 1 .- American wounded soldiers who were in the American hospital near which German bombing planes dropped explosives in the neighborhood of Rarecourt were so little concerned that they refused to leave the building and enter dugouts until compelled to do so by the nurses.

Margery Sawyer of Buffalo, N. Y., and Mabel Butler of New Haven, Conn., Red Cross nurses, said they found these men calm, although the hospital had been damaged and the wards were filled with smoke.

The first thoughts of the nurses whom they had expected to find were regarding the wounded, panic-stricken.
